New Wisconsin Law Requires Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Detectors

Do you have adequate Smoke Alarms and Carbon Monoxide Detectors in your home? Per the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services: As of February 1, 2011, the state of Wisconsin requires both smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms in one and two family dwellings, regardless of the age of the building. The carbon monoxide safety net is for dwellings with fuel burning appliances, fireplaces or attached garages.

Alarms must be installed in the basement, and on each floor levels excluding attics, garages or storage areas. The alarms may be separate or combination units, powered by batteries and separate from the main power system.
